

INFORMATIVE EHR PRESENTATION ASSIGNMENT

PROCESS

- 1. Choose a group leader.
- 2. Exchange contact information for group members.
- 3. Review the Informative EHR Presentation Assignment Details and Grading criteria.
- 4. Assign each group member to find three reputable sources related to their topic.
- 5. Research. Print or bookmark sources.
- 6. Return to groups, present, and discuss the sources.
- 7. Brainstorm, as a group, what direction the group presentation will take with the topic.
- 8. Assign parts of the presentation for each member to research and present.
- 9. Work on individual parts of the presentation. Be sure to use examples or actual cases if you can.
- 10. Meet as a group to check progress of the research and presentation.
- 11. Work as a group to create a PowerPoint or handout that outlines the topic for the audience.
- 12. Work as a group to practice the presentation. Use the Grading criteria to check progress.
- 13. Present as a group.
- 14. Answer audience questions.
- 15. Take a bow- you did great!

ASSIGNMENT DETAILS

- Group presentations should last 10-15 minutes.
- Groups will then have 5 minutes to answer audience questions.
- Note cards should be used by presenters.
- Groups should create a PowerPoint or handout to be used during the presentation.
- Groups must include/cite all sources used in the presentation.
- Sources should be cited on the PowerPoint slides or on the bottom of the handout.
